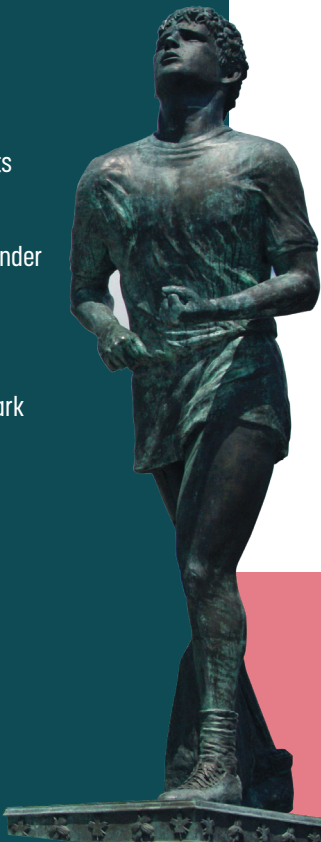

POOL 6 CRUISE SHIP FACILITY

Named for the former grain terminal that operated on the site from 1911 to the early 1990s, this was once the world's largest grain storage capacity terminal. Today, it's one of the Great Lakes most functional secure cruise ship facilities that can handle any cruise vessel needs.
